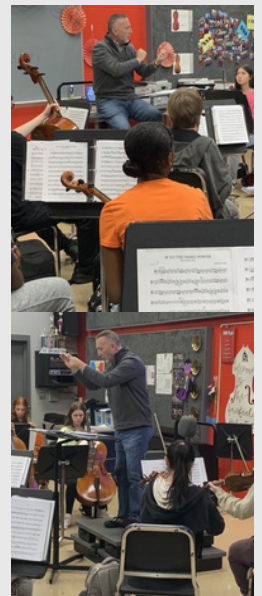


ORCHESTRA
